Rift Amplification

EL34 FX Pedal

The EL34 EQ and Boost pedal accurately recreates the sound, feel, and harmonics of the classic EL34 pentode power valve.

Use with a 6L6, KT66, 6V6, or EL84 powered amp to change the voicing, or plug into an EL34 amp to push those tones even further.

Fully handwired using the same parts and techniques as our amplifiers. This pedal unlocks a new range of tones from your amp with just tap of the switch

Unpacking

Before you plug in, inspect your pedal for any damage.

This pedal was thoroughly inspected and sound-tested prior to shipping, but transportation can sometimes be rough.

If any damage has occurred or if parts are missing, contact either Rift or your retailer immediately.

WARNING

To avoid the risk of shock or fire, do not expose this pedal to moisture (keep your pedal in a dry place).

There are no user-serviceable parts inside.

Any modifications will void the warranty.

Refer all servicing/repairs

to RIFT AMPLIFICATION

Operation

The operation and use of the EL34 is a simple affair - turn it on, turn it up, dial it in.

This pedal requires the industry-standard 9v DC centre-negative power supply to operate.

Using an incorrect power-supply will DAMAGE the pedal and invalidate the warranty

Connections

Connect your guitar to the INPUT, and your amplifier to the OUTPUT

We recommend using high-quality instrument cables and patch leads

VOLUME Control

The EL34 features a single VOLUME control

This adjust the level of the effect sounds. Set the control so there is no volume difference between the effect and straight guitar sounds

TONE Control

The EL34 features a single TONE control

Rotating this knob clockwise generates more upper-mid and high frequencies, rotating CCW will cut these, creating softer, warmer tones.

GAIN Control

When the BOOST switch is activated, this knob controls the extra gain-stage inside the pedal.

Add extra gain, harmonics, and spicyness to your tone by rotating this knob clockwise.

Warranty:

We stand behind every product that we build.

Every Rift product is guaranteed against defects in craftsmanship and components for life, as long as it remains in possession of the original owner - proof of purchase req.

Exclusions

The following items are only covered for certain time periods from the purchase date:

Switches - 12 months

Sockets - 12 months

Any modifications and/or repairs to the pedal not carried out by Rift or our approved repairers, including those done by a qualified technician will void the warranty and any repairs will be chargeable to the customer.

Second-hand products are not supported by the warranty unless agreed by Rift in advance.
